
Our Vision

Increasing Employability of Underprivileged Jordanians through Training on Solar PV Module Installation and Maintenance - DAW



The project aims at developing the skills of the underprivileged Jordanian on Solar PV Module installation and maintenance. Mafraq governorate has large potential for Solar PV projects that need such services, thus the goal is to provide sustainable, scalable, and long-term opportunities for the trainees by the proposed program. The program aims at training and certifying 20 trainees.





Green Innovation Projects as part of the EU support to Green Economy in Response to the Syrian crisis in Jordan 2021 – 2024

This project aims to developing the skills of the Syrian Refugees at Azraq Camp and their host community on three different areas:

- 1. Solar PV module cleaning, site housekeeping and PV operation & maintenance around, 100 people
- 2. Solid waste management (Organic waste/composting) around 40 people
- 3. Organic farming. To support the circular economy opportunities for employment and social inclusion around 40 people


