

Title: Atlas of Energy Efficiency Brazil, 2020, Main Findings

Background

Energy efficiency represents a critical resource to energy systems and the economy, contributing to lower bills, reducing energy waste and increasing competitiveness.

This webinar will focus on the analysis of progress with energy efficiency in Brazil, published in the Atlas of Energy Efficiency 2020 (available in English and Portuguese). The IEA will join Brazil's Energy Research Centre (EPE) and National Union of the Cement Industry (SNIC) to present key findings and recommendations from the report.

This year's Atlas of Energy Efficiency focuses on five sectors: buildings, the residential sector, services, industry, and transport. It features two additional chapters, <u>co-authored with the IEA</u>. The first is a deep-dive into energy efficiency and carbon abatement in the cement sector in Brazil and internationally. The second explores the impacts of the Covid-19 pandemic on energy demand and efficiency.

The webinar will include simultaneous translation between Portuguese and English.
