Speakers' bios



Basilio Dias Araujo is the Deputy for Coordinating Minister of Maritime Sovereignty and Energy Affairs. He has played several key roles in the national, regional and international forums, workshops and conferences delivering papers on the issues of maritime security, maritime terrorism, marine pollution, IUU Fishing, human trafficking, forced labor, modern slavery at sea and other related issues. He was a head of Indonesian Delegation or member delegates at the IMO, FAO, UNEA and other meetings and conferences. Before he was acting as Deputy Director with the Ministry of Home Affairs of Indonesia from 2000-2015 to channel loans and grants to regional governments in Indonesia. He also has experience in working at the Indonesian Mission abroad in Lisbon from 2005-2009. He holds a master of arts in Critical Theory from The Manchester Metropolitan University in the United Kingdom.



Cesar Alejandro Hernandez is the Head of the Renewable Integration and Secure Electricity Unit at the IEA. Mr Hernandez joined in 2017 to work in Electricity Market Design, Electrification and Power sector Decarbonisation strategies. Before he held the position in the Mexican Government as Managing Director for Analysis and Market Surveillance, where he participated in the design and implementation of the Power Sector Reform. Prior to this position, he was an advisor to the Finance Vice Minister in Mexico in energy and environmental issues. From 2007 to 2011 Mr Hernandez was Deputy Chief Economist, at Comisión Federal de Competencia, the Mexican Antitrust Authority. He holds a PhD in economics by the University of Toulouse in France, and a BA in Economics by the ITAM.



Nurul Ichwan is Deputy Chairman for Investment Planning in the Investment Coordinating Board/BKPM of the Republic of Indonesia. Mr Ichwan was the Director of Indonesia Investment Promotion Centre (IIPC)-London from 2015-2018. After being posted in London, Mr. Ichwan had positions as Director for Regional Investment Promotion Facilitation and Director for Services and Zones Planning. Nurul Ichwan holds a Marketing Magister Management degree from Mercu Buana University in Indonesia, and a bachelor in Economics and Development Study from Jenderal Soedirman University, Indonesia.
