- 1. Your use of PAMS constitutes your agreement to these Terms and Conditions. Unless otherwise indicated below, any reference to PAMS in these Terms and Conditions includes a reference to any or all of the Addressing Climate Change Database, Energy Efficiency Database, Building Energy Efficiency Policies ("BEEP") Database and the IEA/IRENA Global Renewable Energy Policies and Measures Database (the "Joint Database") and any other such databases that may be included in this suite of databases in the future.
- 2. PAMS, other than the Joint Database which is subject to joint copyright by the OECD/IEA and IRENA, is subject to copyright by the OECD/IEA. You are responsible for any breach of copyright that you may commit.
