

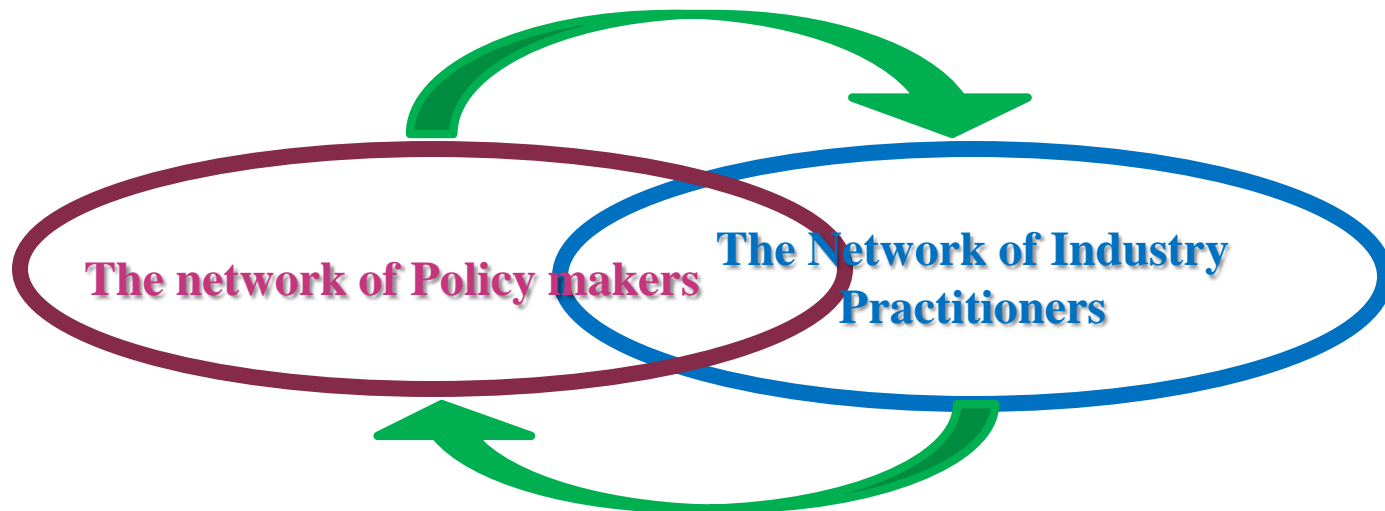
THE OUTLINE OF EMAK AND 1ST WORKSHOP

WHAT IS EMAK

- To promote energy efficiency, effective energy management systems in the industrial sector is essential in addition to technological solutions through deployment of energy efficient products.
- Many countries have already had good experience in policies and industries relevant to energy management and energy managers.
- In order to promote energy management, policy and measures in industry are both essential.
- It is necessary to establish interconnecting 2 networks of major actors; one of policy makers and the other of industry practitioners who are responsible for energy management.



ACTION

- Through steering group meetings of policy makers and representatives of relevant organization or workshops, policy makers and the other of industry practitioners of each country share the best practices.
- Concrete communication tool for information sharing should be set up. Internet-based measures are efficient and effective. (<http://sites.google.com/site/emakbiz/>).
- Meeting output provides with a consolidated report of the existing practices as well as points to be improvement.

THE OUTCOME OF 1ST WORKSHOP

- January 26-27,2010 at IEA headquarter in Paris.
- 16 presentations from 11 countries/institutions (China, Japan, Germany, India, Australia, Mexico, USA, Korea, South Africa and UK) and over 60 attendees
- The presentations provided insights into the energy management institutions and regulatory systems of various countries, and provided a learning experience for all participants with active discussions.
