 - ◆ IEA Committee on Energy Research & Technology (CERT) to support international technology collaboration
 - ◆ National governments to offer a global perspective to national R&D efforts.
 - ◆ IEA Secretariat to support and guide R&D analysis

- Participants highly value exchange of information & in depth discussions during meetings



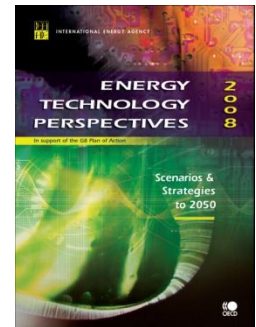
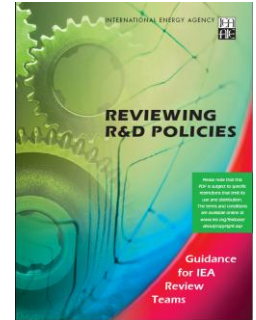

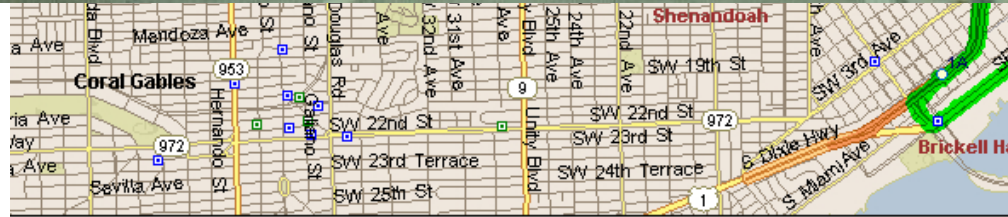
