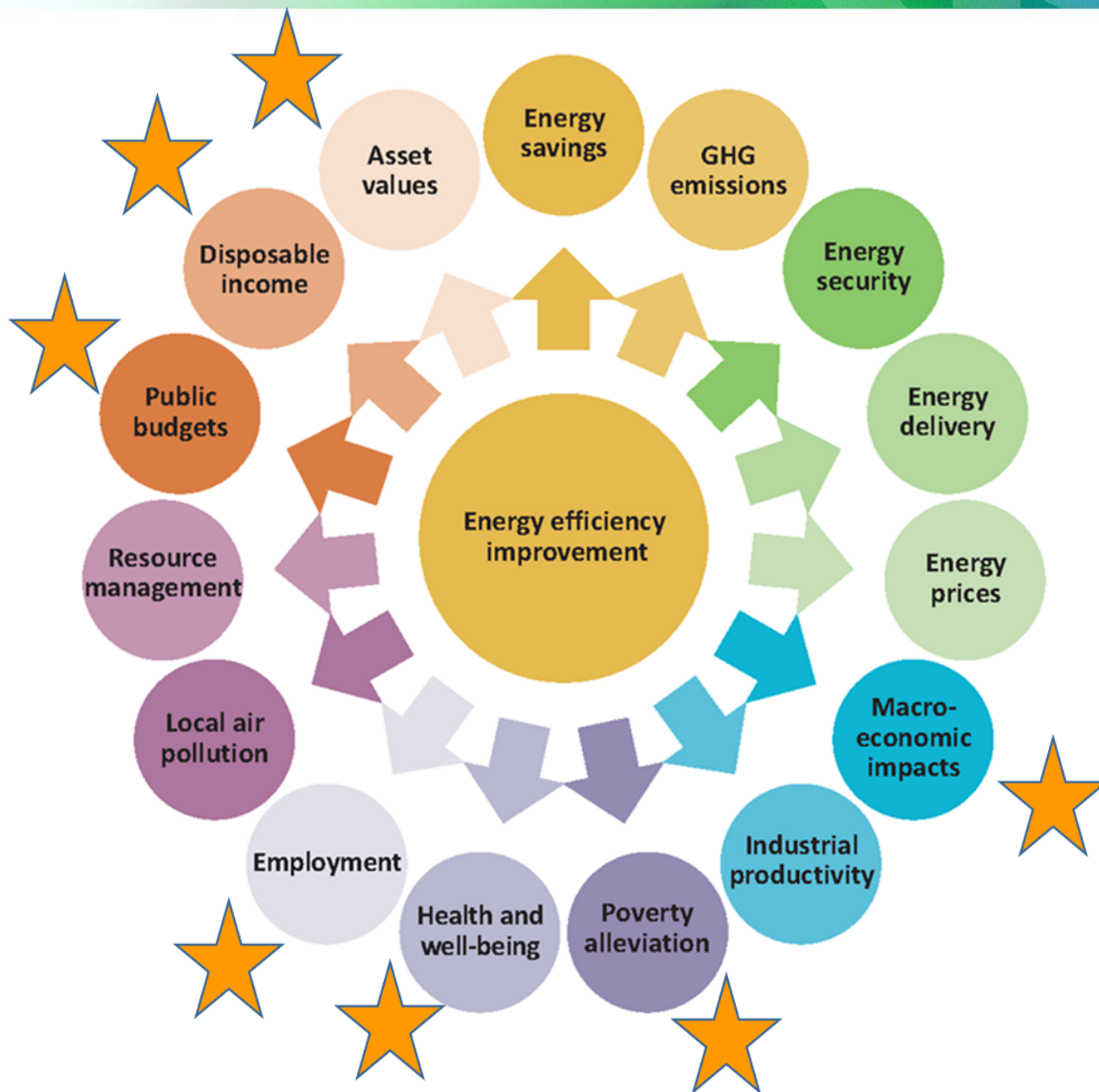
Dirty air prompts free public transport in Paris
