
CALIFORNIA AIR RESOURCES BOARD

KEY CLIMATE LEGISLATION AND EXECUTIVE ORDERS








2016 Total CA Emissions: 429.4 MMTCO2e


CAP-AND-TRADE PROGRAM: CRITICAL TO ACHIEVE SB 32 TARGET







LOW CARBON TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM INVESTMENTS
