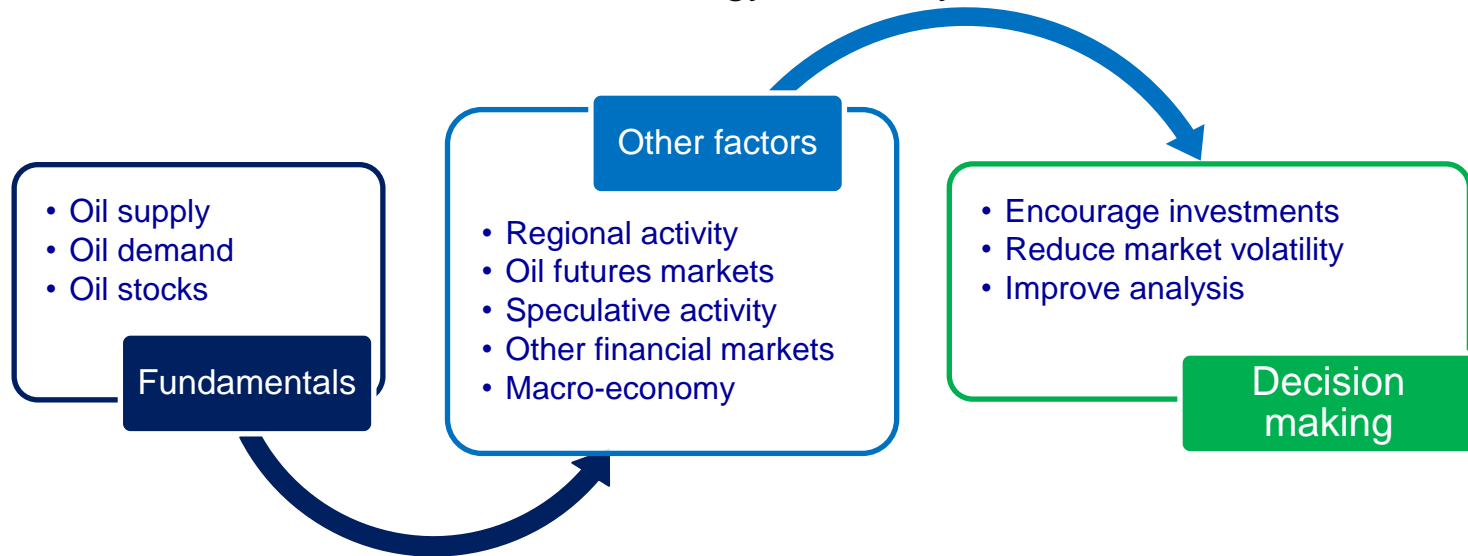

# OPEC a pioneer in energy data collection



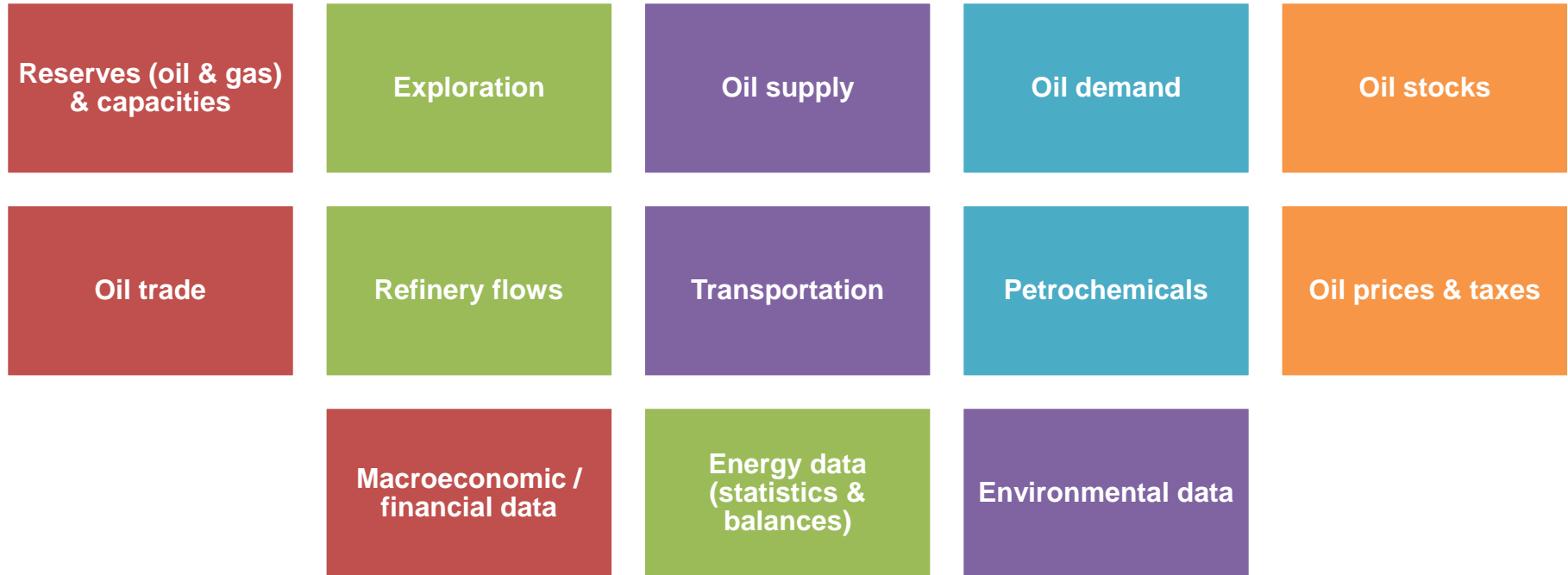
- Energy data collection at the very early stages of the organization
