
The **7th International Energy Forum** host and the co-host statement emphasised the importance of "**improving and timely accessing to energy data**" for "**market assessment and transparency**".

- Tools that were designed for policy makers
 rather than data savvy market analysts





While Engagement Continue: Some Challenges Remain

While JODI is establishing itself as a reference for understanding the oil and gas markets; there remain a number of challenges. They are:

- 1. Many statistics related institutions in countries and economies **still lack human and financial resources** to meet their energy data compilation and reporting needs.
- 2. Some countries **still lack** "**regulatory frameworks**" to ensure that operating companies have requirements to report data necessary to fill JODI Questionnaires to national administrations, and some still have **barriers** that prevent data sharing among government agencies.
- 3. Confidentiality issues still constitute barriers in some countries.
- 4. While JODI has matured, however **progress on data quality** (timeliness, completeness, and reliability) improvement has **stagnated or deteriorated**.
