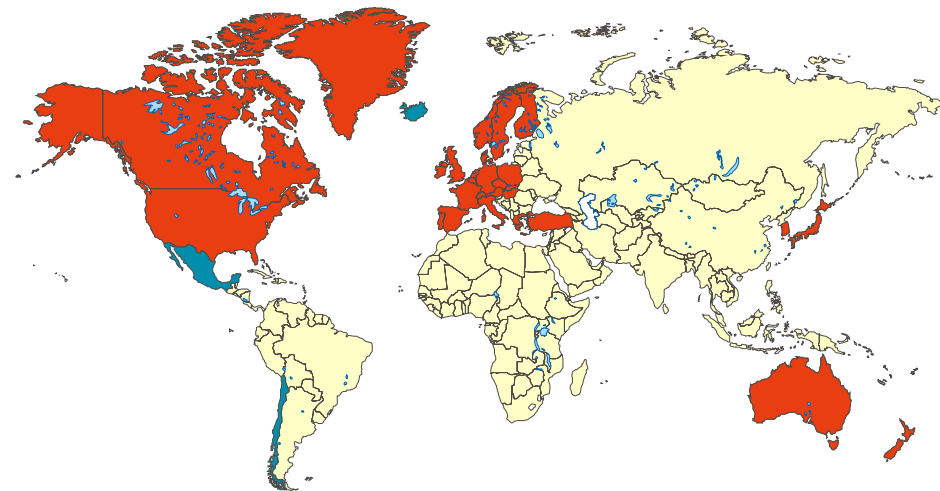

# International Energy Agency

- Inter-governmental body founded in 1973, currently 28 Member Countries
- Policy advice and energy security coordination
- Whole energy policy spectrum and all energy technologies
- Key publications: World Energy Outlook and Energy Technology Perspectives
- Host to more than 40 technology-specific networks (“Implementing Agreements”)
  - Operated independently with their own membership and financing
  - Includes IEAGHG, IEA Clean Coal Centre etc.
- Active in CCS since 2000; dedicated CCS unit created in 2010
  - Provides policy advice
  - Supports broader IEA cross-technology analysis

## IEA International CCS Regulatory Network

- Launched 2008
- Neutral forum for discussing regulatory developments
- Annual face-to-face meetings; quarterly web-based seminars; and ad-hoc meetings on specific CCS regulatory issues
