- Underpinned by global CCS regulatory review
- Identifies 29 key regulatory issues

■ Database will:

- Set out underlying research materials
- Focus on storage-related issues

■ Objective: facilitate access to information, to:

- Support global CCS regulatory development and reform
- Promote IEA CCS Unit responsiveness
