




Challenges to SME confidence

### **Motivation** (in descending order of importance)


- Reduction of energy bill
- 2. Environmental considerations (climate change)
- 3. Improve image
- 4. Increase safety of operations
- 5. Increase value of building through efficient facilities
- 6. Improve product quality

#### Criteria

- Payback time
- Financial support (subsidies)
- Availability and attractiveness of financial products
- Anticipated development of energy prices
- Share of energy costs in total production costs




## **Obstacles for SMEs to invest in EE**
