





ISO 50001 EnMS – UNIDO Pilot Results

LACTIS J.S.C

- Open joint stock dairy company (about 10% on Moldovan market)
- 185 employees
- Management started to look into EE in 2009 to reduce production costs and impact of increased energy prices

Value of EnMS/EE investments planned in 2012 for 2013-2014 was 410,000 USD



70% implemented so far

ISO 50001 EnMS – UNIDO Pilot Results


Toyota South Africa

- > 14 plants, exporting all over Africa, largest portion of the SA market
- 7500 employees
- Management started to look into EE in August 2010 to reduce production costs and impact of increased energy prices, implement measures < 2 yrs

20 more projects planned until the end of 2014



Moved from 2nd worse to 2nd best in terms of Energy intensity in the worldwide Toyota Group


