

Rod Janssen is an expert in energy efficiency and renewable energy policy. He has worked in this field in various capacities since the 1970s at the governmental, international and non-governmental levels. While at the International Energy Agency (IEA) in the 1980s, he led a project that was the first international study to evaluate energy efficiency programmes. He has been involved in Europe-wide energy efficiency and renewable energy policy analysis for two decades (including extensively for the Commission in the 1990s) and he has also worked on many energy and climate change programmes in economies in transition from central and eastern Europe as well as in developing countries on all continents.



Between 2009-2011, Rod was responsible for buildings policy for ECEEE, the European Council for an Energy Efficient Economy and was involved with several other organisations related to energy performance of buildings including the Buildings Performance Institute Europe and the Global Buildings Performance Network. He is also editor of the web service, Energy in Demand.
