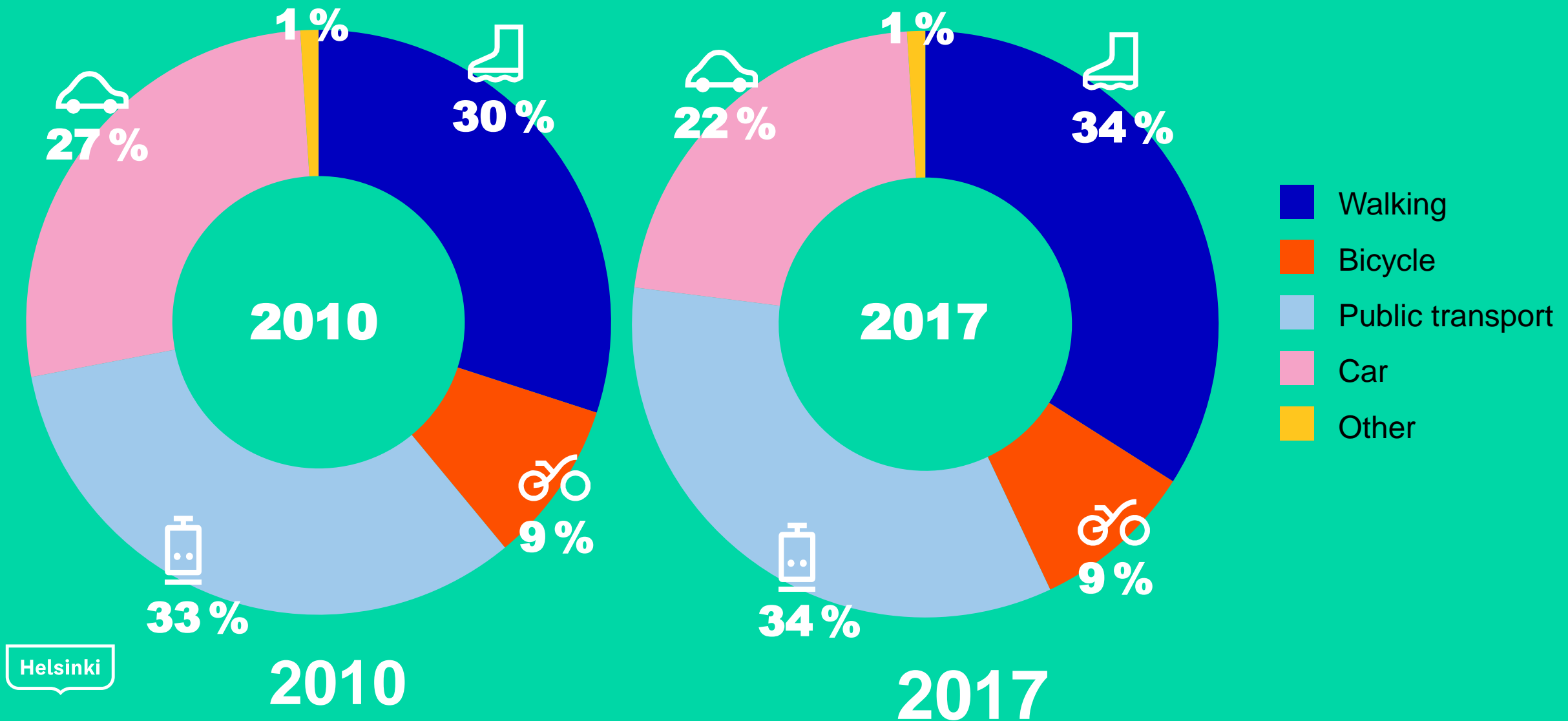


Helsinki takes its own responsibility for the prevention of climate change seriously and ambitiously.

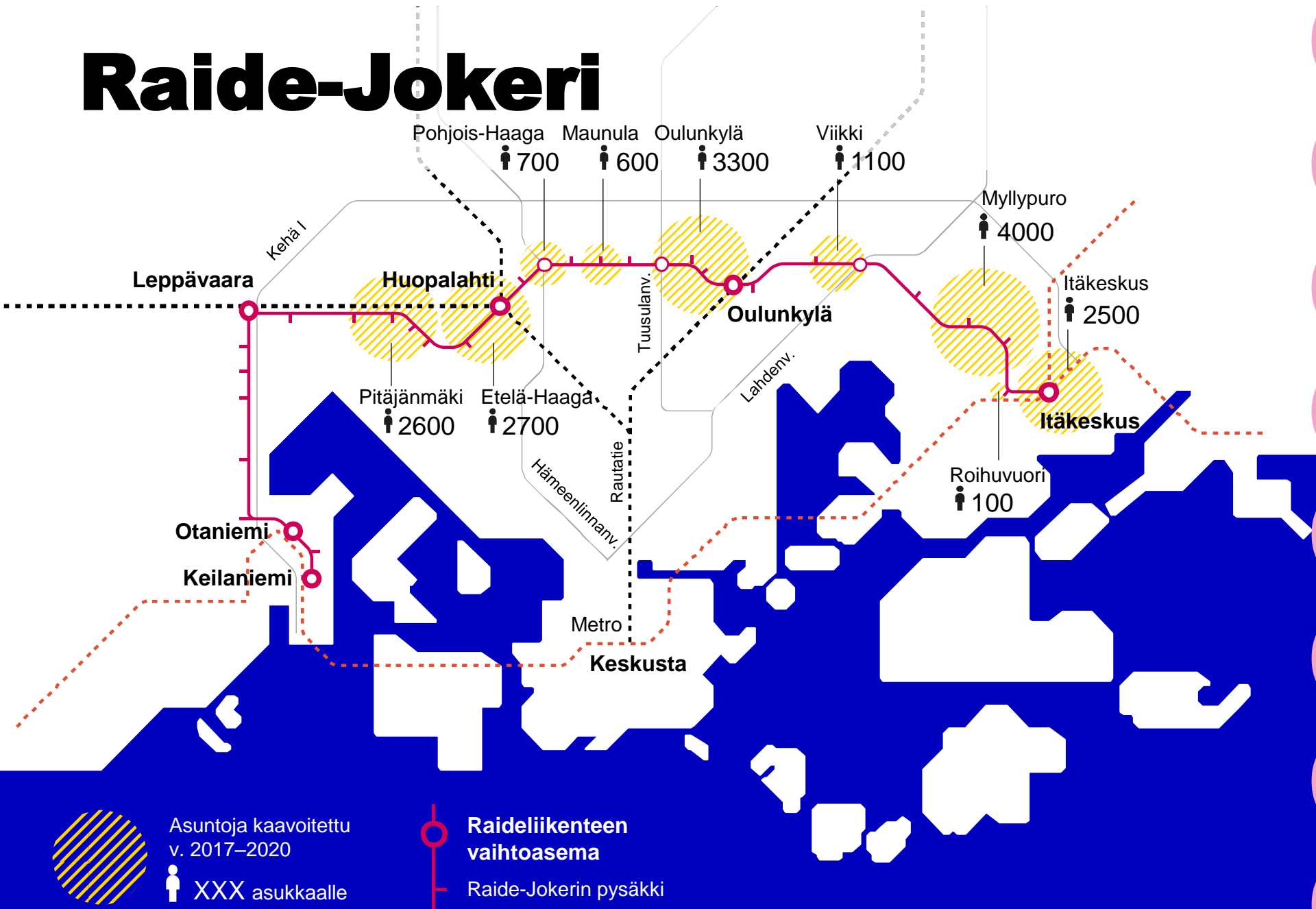
Our goal is to reduce co2 emissions from 1990 to 2030 by 60 per cent, and achieve carbon neutrality by 2035.

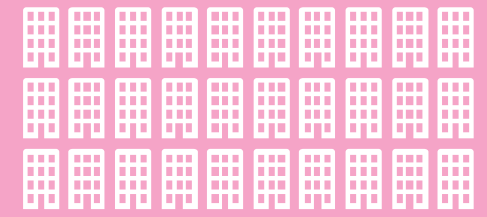

New apartments near Raide-Jokeri in the 2020's



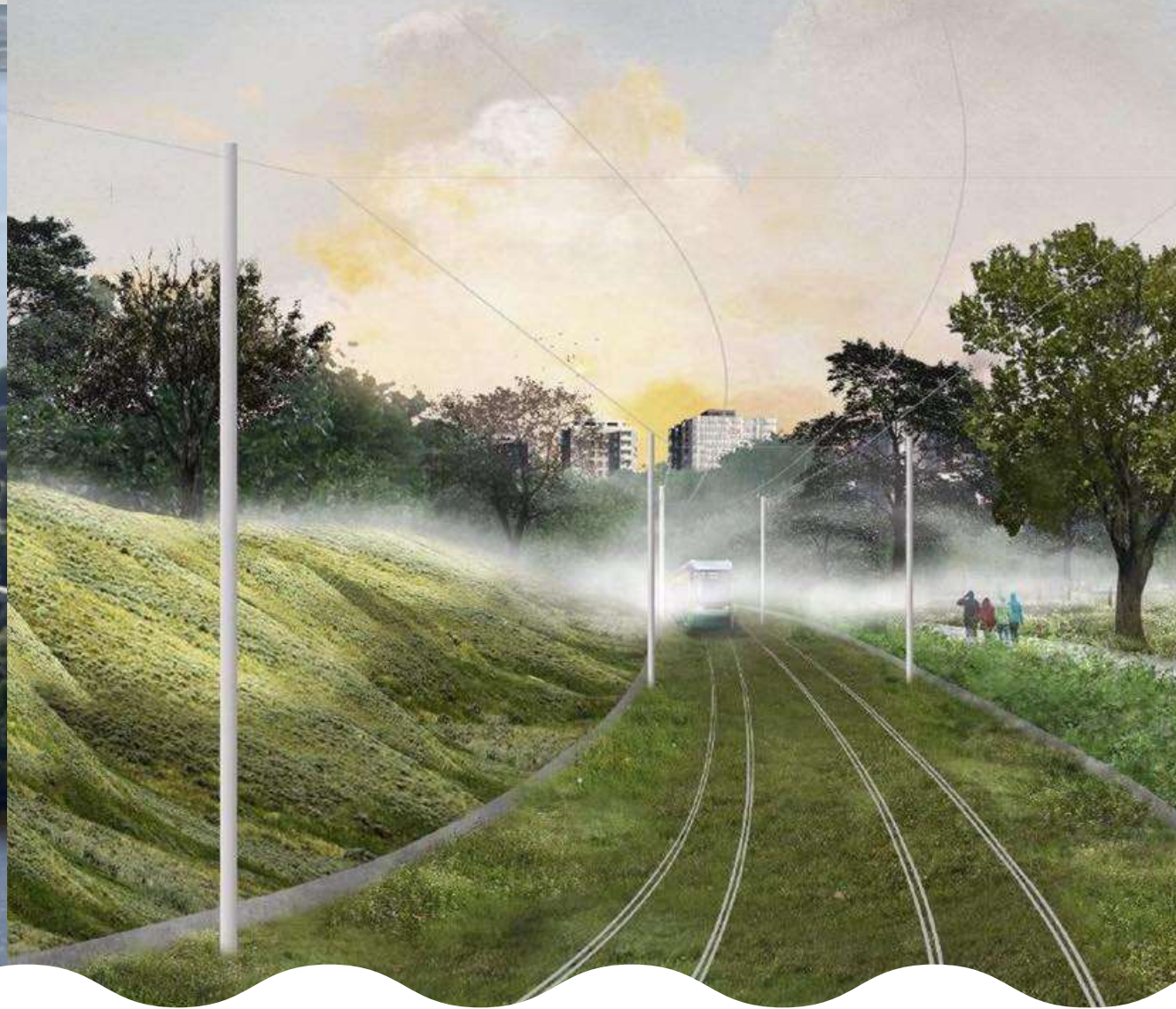
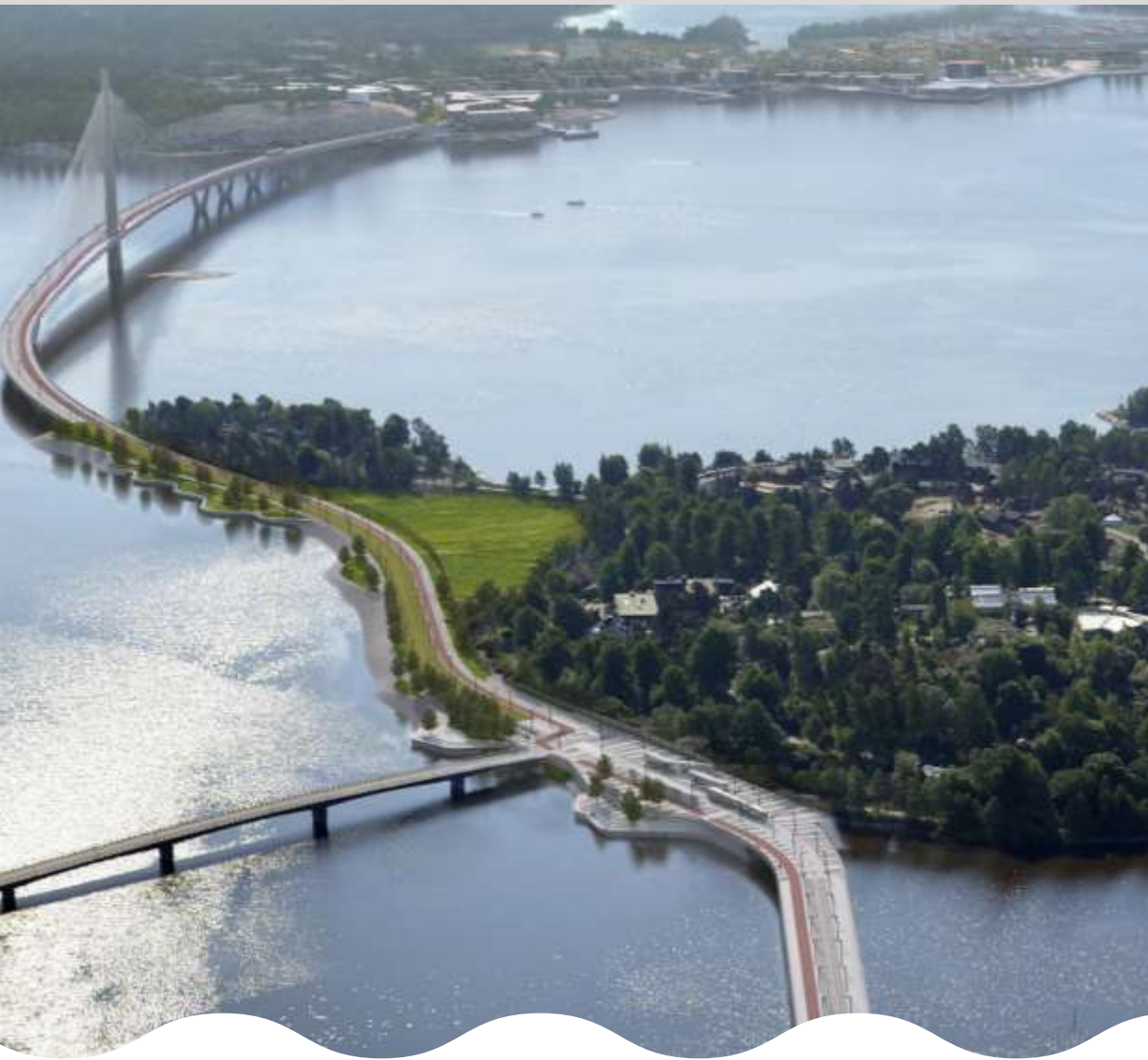
